“B” PROGRAM PHILOSOPHY

Our “B” Program is unique. It is what sets our league above the other leagues in the area. It is “INSTRUCTIONAL” in nature and in fact, designed to allow the younger and less talented players their opportunity to play football.

KIDS..FIRST...KIDS LAST.... AND KIDS ONLY

Because of the diverse circumstances among our members, it would be extremely difficult to establish fair, hard and fast rules. The Program must rely on the **integrity of the coaches** involved with the program. The general guidelines listed below are by no means complete but are presented as examples to illustrate the league’s “B” Program philosophy.

Both winning and losing game coaches will inform the President or Vice President of the details of their game where the difference in score **exceeds 24 points**.

Players who played a significant portion of the “A” game should **NOT** play in the “B” game and certainly **NOT the same position**.

Every player should play, not just the good ones, and not just 1 or 2 plays or on special teams. (No clean jerseys) (1/2 a game is **strongly urged**)

Score is unimportant. What is important is learning and participating.
Move players to different positions to reduce scoring.

Avoid mismatches. Move a dominant player to a different position.
Remember there’s a kid under that helmet.

Press releases are fine, kids love to see their names in print. Remember,
League rules prohibit maintaining “B” records.

The success of your Program is measured not by your wins / losses, but by the number of players that return to play next year. Remember, a **successful “B” experience** builds a **successful TEAM PROGRAM**.
